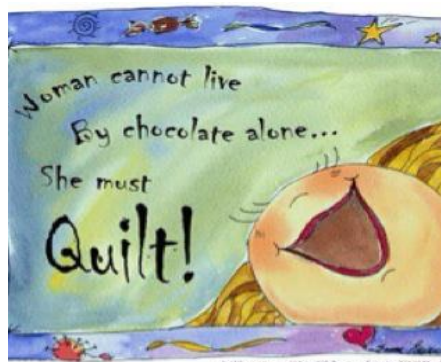

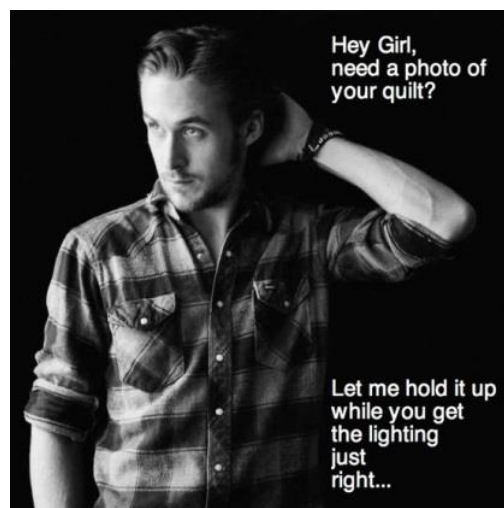

We will be offering 2 classes by Pat Wys in September...SilverThimble Extravaganza and Totally Techniques. Pat is a nationally known quilt designer, lecturer and teacher from Atlanta, GA...We have heard that her book, Spotlight on Neutrals was the hit of last year's Quilt Show. You have the opportunity to get first hand instruction on the project of your choice from that very book! Getting Pat to our guild is expensive but since we will be sharing her expenses with a shop from downstate and possibly another guild from Saginaw, we believe we can swing it...However we will need good class participation to make it work. When you do register for one of Pat's classes your name will be placed in a drawing for a signed copy of Pat's book. The drawing will take place at the July Picnic (you do not have to be present to win).

In addition to Pat in September we will be offering 2 classes in November taught by Ann Loveless, Impressionistic Quilts and Confetti Quilts. These projects are absolutely beautiful so check out the program table at the June guild meeting and seriously consider taking a class or two. It's an excellent opportunity for you that most quilters in this area don't have available to them.
