The Show Committee is working hard to make your show the best ever. If you are a new member, or just have a question, please contact me. I will be on vacation until November 5<sup>th</sup>, so you can email me. There are a few important dates to remember:

**January 1, 2015:** You must be a paid member in order to submit a quilt to our show

**February 1, 2015:** Quilt photos for our postcard cover are due by mail to Shelley

**May 1, 2015:** All registrations and stories for the quilts are due to Kathi Fuller. (Registrations will be printed in the newsletter after the first of the year.)

**Tuesday, June 16<sup>th</sup>:** The work begins on the show. Quilts and boutique items will be due, Time TBA

**Wednesday, June 17<sup>th</sup>:** Judging.

**Thursday, June 18<sup>th</sup>:** Hanging the quilts, setting up boutique, raffle, vendors and everything else

**Friday, June 19<sup>th</sup>:** Quilt Show, 9-6

**Saturday, June 20<sup>th</sup>:** Quilt Show, 9-4

**Challenge Fabric:**

Each show year we sell "Challenge Fabric" for our members to use on a raffle item for our show. This is a major fund raiser for the show, and our guests love the fact that they have over 70 chances to win something in our raffle. **You can make anything for the raffle. The only rule is that at least one of the "Challenge Fabrics" must be visible in your item. It is super fun to see what everyone comes up with.** Linda Schofield will bring in the collected items at each meeting, so we can see what clever things your fellow members are making. It doesn't have to take a lot of time to help. Linda will have fat quarters and half yard cuts to sell at each meeting. 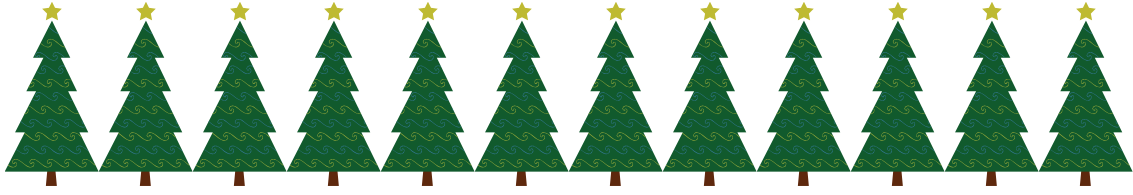
## UFO CHALLENGE

Some of the incentives for rescuing your UFO will be on display January through May at the guild meetings. Just follow the simple rules and "Git Er Done."

The rules:

1. The UFO must be a started project (prior to January 2015) No kits that were purchased and not started.
2. Bring your UFO you want to finish to the January 2015 meeting for show and tell. Share your UFO story - the how, what, where and why you abandoned, neglected or forgot your one time treasure.
3. There is no restriction to the number of UFO's you wish to change to a FO.
4. The challenge ends at the May 2015 meeting. Bring your **finished** UFO back in May for another show and tell and get your prize for a job well done. If you didn't finish it bring it in any way. We want to hear the rest of the story. We might have a surprise for you too.

Now go get that UFO, but don't start working on it until January.
