Piece a QOV top (approx. 64' x80") made in patriotic fabric. 4. Attend a workshop; next one is Nov.7th at Hearts to Holly Quilt Shop, 10-2:30. 5. Make 320" of 2 1/4" bias binding in patriotic colors. 6. Donate jelly rolls (2 make a twin quilt) or quilt shop quality new yardage in 1/2 yard-3 yards or enough for a backing 4 1/2 Yards. 7. Add a favorite veteran to our list.

You may bring any of these to QOV table at any meeting.
